Canadian Work-Permit Assistance

- The Post-Graduation Work Permit Program (PGWPP) allows students who have graduated from a participating Canadian post-secondary institution to gain valuable Canadian work experience.
- A work permit under the PGWPP may be issued for the length of the study program, for a maximum of three years.
- A post-graduation work permit cannot be valid for longer than the student's study program, which must be a minimum of eight months in duration.
- Global MBA students will earn their one year PGWPP post completion of the program successfully.
